Just like you, we're a real-life couple (over a decade strong and counting!), but we also happen to be a pair of rather awesome wedding photographers too!


You're here, reading these words, as you want to know what we're all about. That's exactly why we've put together this guide.

Package

Wedding photography can be mega expensive too.

At B&C, we don't believe it has to be. That's why we offer three easy packages which cover absolutely everything you want out of your wedding day.

All of our wedding photography packages include both Crystal & Dan as your wedding photographers, covering all of the angles like a pair of photography ninjas.

The Half Day

£500 (2023/24) £800 (2025)

This one includes:

- Half day shoot of approx 6 hours (you pick when!)
- 2 x Photographers as standard
- Professional photo retouching after the ceremony
- Your photos delivered on a USB stick in a beautiful personalised wooden box

The Full Day

£950 (2023/24) £1250 (2025)

This one includes:

- Full day shoot, covering everything! Bridal and groom prep, ceremony, speeches, cake cutting and all of the shenanigans in between up until the first dance
- 2 x Photographers as standard
- Professional photo retouching after the ceremony
- Your photos delivered on a USB stick in a beautiful personalised wooden box

All packages will also include a mileage charge of £0.50 per mile.

We totally get it.


Who wants some randomer they've never met before sticking a camera in their face all day long?

On top of that, the engagement shoot is a fantastic way to start your wedding celebrations early by letting all of your family and friends see your engagement shoot, and - as we already mentioned - it just helps break the ice and get you used to your wedding photographers.

Alright - not really. We have a totally simple, easy and wonderful total of four steps to think about to make your engagement photos make everyone on your social media go 'AWWWW, you two are so cute!' and 'Can't wait for the wedding!'

What be these four steps? Well, they're right here.

1. Location

If you're gonna do an engagement shoot, you're gonna need one of these!

Most engagement shoots take place outdoors. Think picturesque woodlands. Think beautiful parks. Think of a place that means something to you.

A beautiful backdrop is a big help when getting equally beautiful photos, but the location is just a backdrop **to you.**

We're very lucky here in the North East of England to have loads of fantastic places on our doorstep for photos. Hamsterly Forest, Castle Eden Dene, Penshaw Monument..the list goes on and on!

If you've got a place in mind - great. If not, we'll help you find one!

2. Outfits

No need for cocktail dresses and top hat and tails here!

Of course you want to look great for your engagement shoot. But the dress code is completely flexible.

As you're probably gonna be outdoors, you'll want something nice and warm but still looks good.

We want you to be comfortable for your engagement shoot, so pick something that gives you that sense of comfort. An item of clothing that when you wear and look at yourself, you feel good about it.

If you really do want to come out in top hat and tails and your best party frock, we're not gonna stop you.

This is **your day.** You wear what you want!



3. Tuning

When will your engagement shoot be?

We'd highly recommend considering this carefully. There's a couple of things that's best to avoid for photography.

We ideally don't want extremely harsh sunlight that'll make shadows all over your faces, but we also don't want complete darkness as there's little light to work with.

It's completely flexible and we'll work around you and your commitments, but an ideal time for an engagement shoot is just before sunset on a clear day. The light is beautiful, there's less people about, and there's loads of great opportunities for awesome photos.

We'll make it work whenever your engagement shoot is, but something to think about!

4. Have Fun!

AKA the most important part of the whole thing!

Like we said on the previous section, getting your photo done can be scary!

Your engagement shoot is all about throwing off these fears, getting used to the camera and trusting your photographers.

The best way to do this is simple - have fun!


Be willing to try out something different. If a pose sounds weird, embrace it, have a laugh about it, and those natural smiles will look so much better than those forced posed photos.

We'll have a chat, have a laugh, take some photos, and we'll all leave feeling great at the end of your shoot.


Once all that prep's out of the way, it's time...you're going to get married!


It really does make a difference.

Editing
