# Top Tips to Save on Your Ledding Essentials

# 1. Wedding Dress

## Newton Hall

The second of our of venues as mentioned above is the stunning Newton Hall in Northumberland, which is also the first venue to offer a beach wedding in the North of England. This means you could save a few pennies having a staycation wedding, rather than jetting off for those beach vibes (you may not be guaranteed the weather though...).

But if you're not after a beach wedding, no bother, there's three other options; from the Garden Suite with its wall of glass showcasing the North Sea and surrounding countryside, the Hall for a more intimate wedding with its mounted deer dressed in pearls (yes, really) and Booth's favourite, The Enchanted Chapel, with its floor to ceiling doors, indoor garden and water feature at the end of the altar.

Quick fact: The Enchanted Chapel was only recently discovered during renovations and hidden away for many years!

## Le Petit Chateau

# As You Like It

The third of our of sister venues that we mentioned earlier and it doesn't disappoint! In fact it was awarded the 'Best City Venue 2019' in the Region in the Wedding Guide.

# Otterburn Castle

Another beautiful venue in Northumberland which is like any other, as it's a genuine castle from the 9th century! Understandably, not everything has survived since the 9th century but if you look closely, you will find original features.

Inside showcases renovated original oak panelling and stained glass windows, giving it a real touch of class and luxury.

# The Secret to Creating Awesome Ugagement Photos!

### SHHHHHHHH - Totally Top Secret Info Right Here...

Alright - not really. We have a totally simple, easy and wonderful total of four steps to think about to make your engagement photos make everyone on your social media go 'AWWWWW, you two are so cute!' and 'Can't wait for the wedding!'

What be these four steps? Well, they're right here.

### 1. Location

# If you're gonna do an engagement shoot, you're gonna need one of these!

Most engagement shoots take place outdoors. Think picturesque woodlands. Think beautiful parks. Think of a place that means something to you.

A beautiful backdrop is a big help when getting equally beautiful photos, but the location is just a backdrop **to you.** 

We're very lucky here in the North East of England to have loads of fantastic places on our doorstep for photos. Hamsterly Forest, Castle Eden Dene, Penshaw Monument..the list goes on and on!

If you've got a place in mind - great. If not, we'll help you find one!

## 2. Outfits

## No need for cocktail dresses and top hat and tails here!

Of course you want to look great for your engagement shoot. But the dress code is completely flexible.

As you're probably gonna be outdoors, you'll want something nice and warm but still looks good.

We want you to be comfortable for your engagement shoot, so pick something that gives you that sense of comfort. An item of clothing that when you wear and look at yourself, you feel good about it.

If you really do want to come out in top hat and tails and your best party frock, we're not gonna stop you.

This is **your day.** You wear what you want!



# 3. Timing

## When will your engagement shoot be?

We'd highly recommend considering this carefully. There's a couple of things that's best to avoid for photography.

We ideally don't want extremely harsh sunlight that'll make shadows all over your faces, but we also don't want complete darkness as there's little light to work with.

It's completely flexible and we'll work around you and your commitments, but an ideal time for an engagement shoot is just before sunset on a clear day. The light is beautiful, there's less people about, and there's loads of great opportunities for awesome photos.

We'll make it work whenever your engagement shoot is, but something to think about!

## 4. Have Fun!

## AKA the most important part of the whole thing!

Like we said on the previous section, getting your photo done can be scary!

Your engagement shoot is all about throwing off these fears, getting used to the camera and trusting your photographers.

The best way to do this is simple - have fun!

Be willing to try out something different. If a pose sounds weird, embrace it, have a laugh about it, and those natural smiles will look so much better than those forced posed photos.

We'll have a chat, have a laugh, take some photos, and we'll all leave feeling great at the end of your shoot.




#### This one includes:

So don't worry - we'll cater our wedding photos on this bit (as with all the way along) entirely to your personal tastes.






